Student Criteria to Qualify:

1. The scholarships are available for Polk county residents only.
2. Undergraduate scholarships only.
3. At least one, possibly both parents must be of Hispanic origin.
4. There must be substantial financial need to qualify.
5. Must be eligible for graduation in the application year.
6. Minimum 2.25 GPA is required.
7. Must have two letters of recommendation from faculty members.
8. Must complete and submit the Club Hispano de Lakeland scholarship application.
9. Must submit a letter to the scholarship committee explaining educational goals, aspirations, and anything else that you feel is important.
- 10. Signed high school transcripts are required.**
11. Club Hispano de Lakeland reserves the right to select the scholarship recipients solely upon their discretion.
12. Scholarships will be awarded after a valid college ID or letter of acceptance has been provided. Scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the financial institution on behalf of the recipient.
13. Scholarship amounts will range between \$1,000 and \$2,000 per student, depending on available funds.
